## Medicaid Covered & Non-Covered Items

### Items & services included in the basic room rate for residents receiving Medicaid:

1. Semi-private room accommodations with furnishings.
2. Regular laundry and linen services (not to include dry cleaning).
3. Housekeeping services.
4. Maintenance services to provide a safe and comfortable environment (exclusive of personal furnishings and equipment).
5. Three meals per day under the direction of the Registered Dietitian.
6. Snacks and nourishments.
7. 24-hour licensed nursing care with a Registered Nurse directing the nursing services.
8. MD medical advisor directing medical care.
9. Confidential medical record services.
10. Medical accessories.
11. Medical supplies needed to provide care to resident.
12. Non-legend drugs, including insulin.
13. Personal health and hygiene items (i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo).
14. Assistive devices used to assist individuals in accomplishing a task.
15. Equipment that can be used by more than one person (i.e. wheelchair, geri-chair, walker).
16. Prescription medications covered by Medicaid.
17. Individual and group social/recreational activities.
18. Social services through a social worker.
19. Religious and pastoral services.
20. Volunteer and auxiliary services.
21. Residents' council.
22. Residents' representative – advocacy services.
23. Family support groups.
24. Mail delivery and pick-up.
25. Social/psychological referral services.
26. Administrative services.

### Services available by contract that can be billed directly to Medicare/Medicaid:

1. Podiatrist.
2. Psychologist.
3. Physical therapy.
4. Speech therapy.
5. Occupational therapy.
6. Respiratory therapy.
7. Ophthalmology.
8. Laboratory services.
9. Diagnostic services.
10. Dermatology.
11. Dental services.

### Items & services not covered in basic daily room rate for residents receiving Medicaid:

1. Oxygen.
2. Beauty/barber services.
3. Non-medical transportation.
4. Medications not covered under the Medicaid program.
5. Private telephone service.

# RESIDENT FOOD STORAGE

Food brought in by family or other visitors will be handled in a way to ensure the safety of the residents.

## PROCEDURES

1. Food items brought in for residents by families or visitors for residents are checked with the nurse to ensure consistency with prescribed diet order(s).
2. Food items that are already prepared by the family or visitor brought in must be labeled and dated.
  - a. The facility may refrigerate label and dated prepared items in the refrigerator.
  - b. The prepared food must be consumed by the resident within 3 days.
  - c. If not consumed within 3 days, food will be thrown away by facility staff.
  - d. The facility will not be responsible for maintaining any reusable container.
  - e. Staff will re-heat foods as needed when that food item is at the appropriate diet consistency.
3. All food items brought in that are manufactured and do not require refrigeration, may be kept in the resident room, preferably in a sealed container.
4. All items not maintained are subjected to being thrown away if not removed by the resident and/or resident representative.
5. If any part of this policy is not followed, the facility reserves the right to protect others by not allowing food items to be brought into the facility for a resident.
